

### A message from our General Manager

Good afternoon Briny,

I hope this finds you well. If you are in the park, I am sure you are noticing lots going on at every angle. Lots of painting, trimming, fixing, replacing and so much more.

We are now at the middle of July and for those of you not in the park, your unit should be closed up and all outdoor belongings well secured or stored inside for storm season. Not doing so is a violation of the Rules and also poses a very serious and dangerous potential situation should a storm approach without enough warning. Please don't wait until it's too late. Numerous violations have been issued, please comply to avoid fining ASAP!

The installation of our Luxspeed Cable continues, now on the west side of the park, District 3 is well underway and they are working in District 4 this week and next. The next steps are to bring the large cables under A1A in several locations and then they will bring things to the new head location under the office. All this work will be done before individual units are connected. We will keep you informed, no need to worry about your individual connections for several months. Most all of you that are still in residence have been very patient with the interruption of your yards, streets and cut AT&T lines thru this process and for that we are very appreciative. It's not easy running fiber optic cabling to 485 units in the very tight quarters that we have in most areas of the park. The men are doing their best to keep the interruptions to a minimum and we will work to get your property properly restored as the project reaches completion.

The installation of our long-awaited fence along Cordova began today. Lots of material delays but we are on schedule for completion as planned.

The new pool cabana is in the early stages of permitting and we hope to have a final decision on the re-surfacing of the swimming pool in the next few weeks. There have been several product price increases in the past few months since the board voted to move this forward. We are still hopeful this can be done before season, but it may be moved to next summer if things don't come together. We will give you additional updates and plenty of notice if/when the pool will be closed.

Remember that you need to call or email the office in advance of guests arriving at the park. We may not be able to help them timely if they show up without notice and that might not be an enjoyable experience for your family or friends. Guest badges and parking passes must be arranged in advance of guest arrival. Remember that **RENTALS must be approved** and there is a process. Your unit **cannot be rented short-term** and hefty fines can be levied if you are caught doing this.

**As we have stated many times, but still receive calls almost daily, you CANNOT and should not have cancelled your AT&T BULK TV CABLE SERVICE before you left Briny.** You can cancel internet and phone but NOT BULK CABLE. If you cancelled your TV service, it is your responsibility to return your equipment to AT&T, otherwise they will bill you for unreturned equipment. Once again, **when the BULK CONTRACT expires**, we will be required to cancel your "account" and return your equipment. This **cannot** be done until the contract expires in November.
