DISTRICT 4 UPDATES

D4 REPAVING will take place next Thursday and Friday, 11/11 & 11/12 weather permitting. (D4 residents received a separate notice on instructions for parking during this time.) There will be **NO** vehicular (car/golf cart etc.) access to HERON, IBIS, MALLARD and BANYAN (in front of D4 only) starting early Thursday AM thru Friday afternoon when the paving is complete. This means there will be no vehicular access to the District, quonset huts, chiseler's club etc. IF you need to move things out of one of these buildings, you need a golf cart, bicycle etc. PLEASE have this done by the end of the day Wednesday. You will be able to WALK in most of these areas although there will be a lot of large trucks and you should only go as necessary. We are sorry for any inconvenience this may cause.

DISTRICT 4 water is safe for drinking and cooking. If this changes, you WILL be notified. All units in D4 are still connected to the old water lines. At the completion of this project, both new and old water lines will run until our men have time to change over each unit from the old lines to the new lines. This will be done "in-house" as it was not part of the larger contract. If you are in residence you will be notified at the time your unit is being switched over as you will be without water for a short period of time.

This may require you to remove the vacation hold a week prior to your return so they can check. If AT&T in not working, call 866-299-8624 so that they can get you fixed. “ In memory of Louis L. Spano who divided time between his loves: Family, Photography, Public Safety and Rita Taylor. After retiring from a successful career with the New York Police Department, Mr. Spano had a successful career with the Ocean Ridge Police Department. In 1964, he joined Ocean Ridge Police Department as a Patrolman, then became Top Cop as a result of his promotion to Police Chief in 1969. When the Ocean Ridge Fire and Police Department were merged in 1972, Mr. Spano became the Director of Public Safety. In 1971 Mr. Spano was awarded the U.S. Coast Guard’s highest civilian award, Silver Life Saving Medal, for his heroic efforts when he jumped into the Boynton Beach Inlet to rescue and bring four people to safety after their boat capsized. Mr. Spano retired from Ocean Ridge Public Safety in May 1989 for health reasons. ”
