Andy joined the Electrical Engineering and Computer Science (EECS) faculty at UC Berkeley in 1966 and retired after 41 years of classroom teaching. Andy married “Bev” Hufford in 1963 and they had two daughters. He married Cynthia “Cindy” Collins in 1979 and had two more daughters. Andy and Cindy moved to the retirement community of Rossmoor in Walnut Creek, CA where they enjoyed attending family gatherings and traveling to places where the birds would gather. Andy & Cindy especially enjoyed spending winters in Briny Breezes where Andy happily pursued his love of singing and dancing with the Curtain Raisers and visiting the many bird sanctuaries where his camera was never idle. Many in Briny will remember his tireless efforts to improve the sound and lighting in the Auditorium. Andy is survived by Cindy, his four daughters Natalie, Georgia, Jenny & Samantha and their spouses, his grandchildren Kevin, Tom, Dylan, Sarah, Edwin, and Patrick and his three sisters @ **E-4** Cynthia Beckett, Marjorie Cline and Janet Burkhart and their families.
