Water Line Replacement – District 4

The water line replacement project has begun. The goal of completion is by Thanksgiving. There will be NO interruption to unit water service during this portion of the project.

They have begun on Mallard Drive, and will be working there for the next 2 weeks, working their way south. Trenching along the front of trailers/street side will be done in stages and at low tide. There will be digging but this should be minimal interruption to your day. If you park your car on your driveway, it should not affect you. You will be notified as they are finishing up a section and will be advised which days you will need to move your car if it is parked on the street. If you are along IBIS or HERON and park in front of your unit, your vehicle will need to be moved off the road during this process. We will give you notice, and parking can be up under the banyan trees. **If you are NOT in Briny and have a car on the road, PLEASE contact the office ASAP and confirm arrangements have been made for your car.** Notice will be given but if cars are not moved, they will have to be towed as we cannot hold up the project.

We will update you as we get more information and as they are proceeding into your areas. We anticipate this being a very smooth project and we appreciate your patience as we move forward on this very important project.

Don't forget! We will be experiencing King Tides again this month until the end of the year:

- October 5-11
- October 20-21
- November 3-9
- December 2-7

Be prepared to see local impacts during the week surrounding these dates. We were very fortunate that we did not experience high water levels during King Tides in September. Other weather conditions may impact the timing and severity of the upcoming King Tides – for example heavy rains, tropical conditions including higher winds and waves may cause higher than expected tides with longer durations.
