My note this week is important. I want to encourage everyone to get ready for the Annual Meeting that will occur on February 26, 2020 at 9:30. If you are interested in working for this great community and are in district 2 please send in your intent to run for the board. This district has an open seat. District 1 and 3 also have open seats and have 2 candidates on the ballot each. Of course if you are interested in those districts you may bring in your intent to run for the Board of Directors. The deadline for the intents are next Friday January 17, 2020.

**I am encouraging EVERYONE to vote this year.** We need a quorum of 51% of the total number of shares outstanding of the corporation, represented by stockholders who attend the meeting in person and/or mailed ballots RECEIVED up to the time of the meeting. I would like you to understand that your vote is not counted as a NO vote if you do not vote. People think that this will be seen as a no vote. NOT True. Nothing passes, nothing moves forward without your votes.

The time, energy and your money spent to present items to the ballot are important to moving Briny forward. We will be asking each district to form telephone trees, and knock on doors to get the votes in.

One more Voting fact: If you cannot attend the annual meeting the Secretary of the Cooperative is appointed as your limited Proxy. He represents the vote that you place and he MUST be in attendance. If for some reason you appoint another Shareholder to be your

limited Proxy, they MUST attend the annual meeting. Last year there were many disqualified votes due to the fact that the Proxy holder was not in attendance at the Annual Meeting.

***This is your community, if you want it to continue to thrive you need to vote!***
