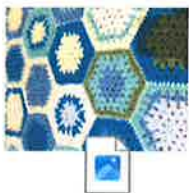

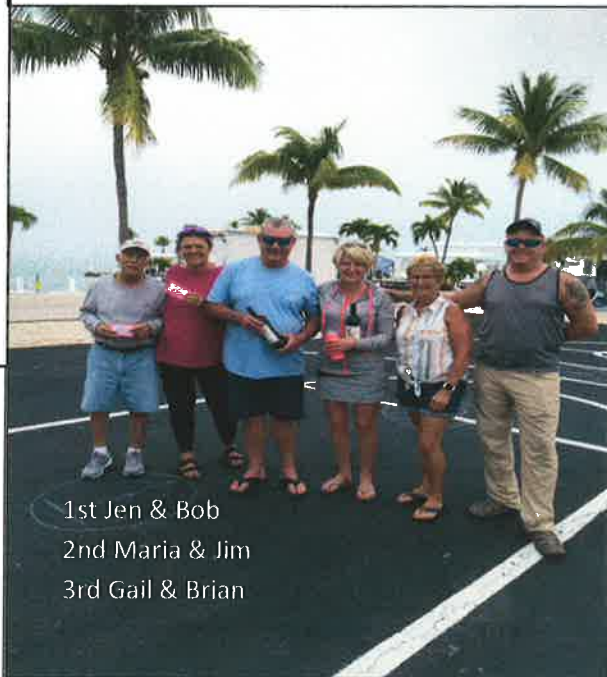

5. If you are unable to attend the lottery, write a note designating a proxy. Proxy gives note to Chairperson, gets your Lot # and pays if your Lot # is called.
6. A wait list is formed if all tickets have been sold but Lot #s remain.
7. If you are unable to use your ticket, contact the Chairperson who will give you contact information of the next person on the waiting list.
