Where are the Pavement Pounders?

The Pavement Pounders (Los Caminantes Recreativos) have begun their 2022-23 virtual walk through the country of the United Mexican States (Mexico). Their first leg starts in Ciudad Juárez, in the Mexican state of Chihuahua, and ends in Durango City, in the Mexican state of Durango, for 670 miles. This 670 mile leg in Northern Central Mexico consists of rugged mountainous terrain with heavily forested areas and wide river valleys. Currently the Pavement Pounders are in El Sueco, Chihuahua and they have completed 136 miles of their journey.
