Non-contact temperature taking and completion of covid screening questionnaire ,outside the Lower Rec, are require for entry.

Bingo will be held in the Upper Rec. There is room for 20 card tables and 3 6' banquet tables. Maximum capacity will be 48 players. Tables will be sanitized prior to playing. Sanitized chairs will be provided, however bring your own chair is appreciated. Bingo workers will be gloved as well as masked. Only they will touch cards, tickets and money. A sanitized start up bank will be provided. All moneys received will be sanitized prior to redistribution.

Players are not allowed to choose a sanitized card, to secure safety cards will be handed out. Players may bring snack and drink but may not share with any other table in the venue. Players are required to practice safe distancing when using the restrooms.

CORNHOLE:

TEAMS - mixed couple makes a team - one male & one female - sign up together is preferred - single participants can register but will only qualify to play if matched with opposite sex participant also looking for partner - first in first matched;

From the Rec Directors: All boards and bags will be sanitized prior to match. Each player will be *required* to use hand sanitizer before their match. Players **MUST** stay 6 feet apart or wear a mask.

Happy Hour Protocols

Happy hour that is normally on Thursdays, will be held as a First Friday event on the Basketball Court every other Friday from 4-6.

Food: Instead of a buffet, each table will be responsible for their own snacks, no sharing among tables.

Tables: There will be a table sign up sheet on the Lower Rec bulletin board just like for dances, which means you will find a group of people you want to sit with and sign up on the sheet. 3 couples or 6 people per table. Tables will be 6 feet apart and masks must be worn unless eating or drinking. Tables will be covered with plastic and can be removed and thrown away after the event.

Chairs: Will be sanitized before and after the event by the coordinators. You will not need to put them away as before.

Masks: must be worn when leaving tables

Other information for each activity:

Karaoke Singers/Entertainers: will continue as usual except using a computer with the lyrics shown instead of a TV. The following requirements will be observed:

One singer at a time, no duets.

Microphone will be cleaned with Clorox wipes by the emcee after each singer/entertainer has completed their song or joke/story.

Gloves, that will be supplied, may be worn by singer/entertainer while handling the microphone, but are not required.

Request forms are to be filled out by one person at each table, they will be considered the secretary and the only one who will turn in the forms.

Trivia: will continue as usual except each table will verify their own answers and the secretary for the table will read off the score when requested by emcee.
