ORLK now has a new dog park, located next to the playground. In compliance with the Monroe County New Leash Law this new park is the **ONLY** place on ORLK property your dog is allowed off the leash,

Monroe County Leash Law — The Monroe County Board of Commissioners amended the Monroe County *Code to require animals in public places to be on a leash.*

"Effective voice command" is no longer an acceptable means of control for an animal in a public place. The regulation requires a physically capable person to be in control of an animal by means of a leash; or for the animal to be enclosed by a secure fence or other means of confinement. 44th ANNUAL OUTDOOR RESORTS FISHING TOURNAMENT January 2, 2020- March 20, 2020 TOURNAMENT RULES

There are three (3) contests. The first tournament begins January 2, 2020 and closes January 26, 2020 AT 4:45 PM, the second contest begins January 27, 2020 and ends February 21, 2020 AT 4:45 PM, and the third contest opens Friday, February 22, 2020 and ends March 20, 2020 at 4:45 PM. The awards ceremony is March 27, 2020.

In the event a species of fish has its "fishing season" closed, said species will be removed from the tournament. An angler weighing in a fish must be registered in the tournament.

Anglers may fish from canals in the park, the three mile bridge, or a boat, provided the boat leaves from and returns to the Bayside Market at Outdoor Resorts. Angling methods are restricted to rods and reels, bait, lures and hand lines. No electric downriggers or reels are permitted. No professional guides or commercial fishing equipment may be used in this contest. Participants must be current residents (either owners or renters) of Outdoor Resorts. There will be no ties. The first fish caught of top weight in any category wins. Bayside Market employees or two members of the fishing tournament committee are official weighmasters. All fish must be caught between the hours of 6:00 am and 5:00 pm and weighed in on the day caught.

The tournament will be closed on the date of the annual general meeting. Any fish caught on this day are ineligible for weighing in. When Bayside Market is closed for any reason, fish are ineligible for weighing in. Each angler must complete and sign a certificate that the entry was caught in compliance with these rules. It must be witnessed. If the angler fished alone, the weighmaster (Dave Corbet) will witness. In case of a question to the species of a fish, two members of the committee will determine the species. If two members are not readily available, the weight of the fish should be recorded and the fish put on ice for species clarification asap
