Crane Point Museum and Nature Center, a 63-acre tropical oasis with museum, gardens and trails, operated by The Florida Keys Land and Sea Trust. 9am-5pm daily. Call 305-743-3900 for a guided tram ride reservation.

Florida Keys and History Discovery Center. Permanent exhibits of early culture and history of the Florida Keys, rotating exhibits, films, and tanks operated by Mote Marine. Wednesday to Saturday 10am-5pm. No reservation necessary

Pigeon Key Foundation and Marine Center, a five-acre island only accessible by boat. This used to house 400 workers during construction of Henry Flagler's Overseas Railway. Guided historical tours and access to key daily. Snorkelers must bring own equipment. Ferry departs Visitor's Center 10am, 12pm, 2pm and departs Pigeon Key 12:15pm, 2:15pm, and 4pm daily. Times change dependent on weather. Call 305-743-5999.
