## **Lottery Procedures**

- 1. Attendance is not required.
- 2. Priority will be given to owners in both lotteries. If spaces are still available after the lottery, a second drawing will be held for renters.
- 3. Priority for wet slips will be given to dry lot owners. However, if an owner has multiple dry lots, then all the owner's lots will be entered in the drawing. Once one of the lots has been awarded a slip, the remaining lot numbers will be removed from the drawing.
- 4. Once all the proper paperwork is received the corresponding lot will be entered in the drawing.
- **5.** Each approved entry will be assigned a corresponding numbered ball which will be randomly drawn lottery style at an open meeting.
- **6.** Management will assign wet slip and trailer parking numbers then notify all lottery winners.
- 7. Once all Marina slips and Lot 9 spaces have been assigned and there are no owners on the waiting list, renters may rent empty Marina slips and/or Lot 9 spaces at a rate of \$100 per month for the Marina and \$30 per month for Lot 9.
- 8. If a unit is rented during the lease period owners are not permitted to participate.

## **Sharing Wet Slips Procedures**

- 1. Owner's MUST declare the sharing of the slip BEFORE the drawing.
- 2. The two (2) lot owners agree to share one (1) spot for ONLY their registered vessels.
- 3. The park does not get involved or mediate for the two (2) lot owners. The park will recognize one as the primary which will be held responsible in any discrepancy.
- 4. Both registered vessels must fit in the awarded slip.

# RENTAL REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR OWNERS

- 1) Rental Registration must be signed by all parties and must be filed with the main office at least 14 business days in advance and not more than three 3 months in advance. A \$25 registration fee will be charged to the owner's account on the tenant's month of arrival. Late processing fee is \$100.
- 2) Rentals must be for a minimum of 30 days and must be to a single family or individual (maximum of 5 people). Overnight guests will count towards occupancy.
- 3) Owners are responsible for supplying the renters with the Rules & Regulations, available at the office & www.orlk.org
- 4) The owner is responsible for all citations that will be given to renters for violating any of the Rules and Regulations.
- 5) Monroe County requires you to have an occupational license if you rent your unit for less than 6 months.

#### INFORMATION FOR RENTERS

- 1) No subletting.
- 2) Guests must be registered with Safety.
- 3) All vehicles, golf carts, boats, trailers, and personal watercrafts (PWC) must have the tenants' name on the registration and must be registered with Safety upon arrival. Guests are not permitted to bring in any golf carts, boats, trailers, nor PWCs.
- 4) Decals on all vehicles, golf carts, boats, trailers, and PWCs must be visible.
- 5) Only two barcodes per unit with cost of \$5.
- 6) Quiet hours are from 11PM to 8AM. Curfew shall be observed between the hours of 11PM and 6AM for all persons aged 17 and under unless accompanied by parent or adult age 21 or older.
- 7) Golf cart drivers must have a learner's permit or have a valid license if under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult over 21.
- 8) Golf carts, bikes, and walkers must have lights at night.
- 9) Bicycles must be equipped, when operated at night, with a front light and a rear red reflector (or red light).
- 10) Any person under the age of 16 must wear a helmet while riding a bicycle, battery powered scooters, or skateboards.
