BYLAWS - ARTICLE IX - COMPLIANCE AND DEFAULT - SUBSECTION 9.4 -

"The failure of the Association, or any unit owner to enforce any covenant, restriction or other provision of the Condominium Act, the Declaration, these Bylaws, or the Rules & Regulations adopted pursuant thereto, shall not constitute a waiver of the right to do so thereafter."

- 1. It shall be the responsibility of the unit (lot) owner to submit to the Association twenty (20) copies of the following Variance Application, along with twenty (20) copies of completed "Unit Improvement forms" and scale drawings, two (2) weeks prior to a Board of Directors Meeting. The cost of the forgoing shall be the responsibility of the unit (lot) owner.
- 2. Variance Applications received later than two (2) weeks prior to a Board Meeting shall not be considered at that meeting.
- 3. Notice of intent shall be sent to all unit owners within a distance of sixty (60) feet. Confirmation of notice shall be required.
- 4. The unit (lot) owner or Agent shall be responsible for the presentation of the Variance Application to the Board of Directors.
