## GOING AWAY CHECKLIST - OWNERS

Below is a suggested check list for you to follow whenever you leave your Wedgewood Lake condo unit unattended for an extended period of time.

- 1. Remove perishable items from the refrigerator. Turn ice-maker "OFF" but leave refrigerator on.
- 2. Run the garbage disposal, checking to make sure it is clean. Fill sinks with cold water and flush down with disposal to clear lines.
- 3. Prop open the dishwasher door to prevent mold growth from residual moisture.
- 4. Turn off main water supply line to your condo unit to prevent damage to your unit and others in case of leakage. IMPORTANT: If you are having someone periodically doing security checks or inspections of your unit and to flush sinks and toilets, leave written instructions for that person to turn off main water supply line before exiting your unit.
- Wrap a thick layer of plastic wrap across and around all of your toilets. Close the toilet seat and place a heavy object on top. This will help prevent the water in the bowl from evaporating and rodents from entering.
- 6. Unplug TV and TV cable boxes. Unplug other non-essential electrical appliances that use electricity (e.g. clocks on night tables, microwave oven, computers, etc.)
- 7. Turn down the volume on the phone so it won't ring endlessly for outsiders to hear and know you're not home.
- 8. Leave inside closet doors ajar.
- 9. Close drapes and blinds.
- Set your air conditioner on automatic at about 80 degrees, unless you have other automatic controls. This will help prevent mildew growth in hot weather.
- 11. Turn off inside and outside lights.
- Remove all moveable objects from lanais and patios; keep in mind a hurricane could turn objects into flying missiles.
- 13. Check all doors and windows for locks and secure the unit.
- 14. Cancel newspapers and leave mail forwarding information at the Post Office.
- 15. Switch your hot water heater to "OFF" position.
- 16. Return the SEASONAL CLOSING AND CHANGE OF ADDRESS FORM to Miller Management Services.
- 17. Leave a copy of this CHECKLIST in a prominent place in your unit (e.g. on the kitchen counter beside the sink).
