Installation includes all lights, extension cords, decorations for displays and regular maintenance of lights.

For the safety of our workers, the closure or partial blocking of some roads or areas may be required during the installation period.

Displays: Installation of larger displays such as sign enhancers, may require drilling into mounting surface to ensure safe installation. It is the customers responsibility to ensure mounting surface is free of damage and in adequate condition to accommodate display. All Star Electrical Services & Holiday Lighting will not install displays on deteriorated surfaces. Any required patch work or painting that may be needed on mounting surface after removal of display is the responsibility of the owner.

Availability: Availability of quoted Displays & other decorations are on a 1<sup>st</sup> come. 1<sup>st</sup> serve basis. All Star Holiday Lighting will try its best to match like for like quoted above. However, we cannot guarantee any availability of decorations quoted above for proposals approved after August 30<sup>th</sup> of proposed year, due to potential shipping & availability shortages.

## Installation Equipment

Lighting installations above 10ft will require the use of large machinery such as bucket trucks and/or service lifts. For installations requiring more than 1 installation day, customer must provide adequate overnight parking for machinery throughout the installation period.

## Landscape Trimming, Hedging and Mowing

All trimming/mowing should be done 1 week prior to the installation date. All Palm Trees must be trimmed, cleaned & have dead palm fronds removed prior to installation of lights. There will be an extra charge for any tree that requires frond removal/trimming.

\*Please note our installars are not landscapes & will only remove trimmings that impede installation. Any required trimming will be left at the property for landscapers to dispose of. Please advise landscapers of existing lights & components placement after installation is complete. Any damage of lighting, components, and/or equipment caused by trimming/mowing after installation will be charged to the customer as stated under additional charges.

### Sprinklers

Sprinklers should be reprogramed to turn on during daylight hours and allow for a minimum 3 hour dry time prior to the lights turning on in the evening. Sprinkler heads should be aimed away from lights.

### Electrical Specifications:

Electrical outlets are required within 25' feet of installation area. Outlets should be on a dedicated circuit with a 20 amp minimum breaker/fuse and free from damage. Bubble covers should be installed on all outlets to avoid water intrusion. It is the customers responsibility to ensure adequate outlets are available for lighting installations prior to installation date. A separate proposal for outlet installation can be provided if needed, upon request.

### Pedestrian Traffic:

Due to the many components & wiring on the ground, No pedestrian traffic is allowed around lighting areas. It is the communities responsibility to ensure these areas are blocked off from pedestrian traffic.

### Maintenance.

All balances due must be paid in full in order for maintenance to be provided.

Site inspections will be completed on a weekly basis to ensure all lights are working properly & repair any lights that may be out. If there is an outage between inspections please contact us at 305-964-7768 to report outage. A service technician will be sent within 48hrs. Please note: any damage caused by others will become an additional charge.

Tripped GFCI's are normal and not covered under maintenance. Please see troubleshooting tips before calling a maintenance technician to avoid any additional charges below.

To help reduce any additional costs incurred, follow these simple troubleshooting tips:

Ensure the bubble covers are completely closed to avoid moisture at the GFCI outlet.

Check that all cords are properly connected

If lights don't turn on, check the GFCI outlet to make sure the GFCI has not tripped (red light on).

If the red light is on remove all electrical plugs from outlet. Reset the tripped outlet by pressing the reset button and re plug all electrical plugs. For tripped outlets due to water intrusion, please allow a minimum of 6 hours dry time before re-setting the tripped outlet. Outlet must be completely dry before re-setting & re-plugging in the electrical plugs. Otherwise, it will continue to trip. That is what the GFCI is meant to do.

## 2025 LEVEL UP MOBILE GYM LICENSE AGREEMENT

THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT (hereinafter "Agreement" or "License"), made as of this 1st day of MAY, 2025, by and between WINSTON PARK ASSOCIATION, INC., a non-profit Florida corporation, 8100 SW 132, Avenue, Miami, Florida 33183 (hereinafter designated as "Association" or "Licensor"), and Daniel Prol / Level Up Mobile Gym, LLC (hereinafter designated as "Licensee").

1. <u>License for use of property</u>. In consideration of the remuneration to be paid and the covenants and agreements to be performed by Licensee, Licensor does hereby License **part-time use** of that certain real property located at

hereinafter designated as the "Property" subject to zoning ordinances, restrictions, encumbrances, limitations.

- 2. <u>TERM AND RENEWAL</u>. This License shall be effective for a term commencing on <u>1st</u>, of <u>September 2025</u>, and shall expire on <u>30th</u>, of <u>April 2026</u>.
- 3. REMUNERATION AND OTHER CHARGES. In consideration of this License of the Property and the right to the limited use of said locale as set forth below, the Licensee, as payment of consideration to the Licensor agrees: to pay remuneration on the first day of the month classes commence for the approved activity. The remuneration is to be paid to Winston Park Association, Inc., and to be delivered to Licensor at Winston Park Clubhouse.

Initial Licensee\_\_\_\_/Initial Licensor\_\_\_\_\_\_\_

- a. REVENUE SHARING. The INDEPENDENT INSTRUCTOR shall pay to the ASSOCIATION a licensing fee in the sum of \$200.00 per month for group lessons.
- b. Licensing fee payments shall be paid by the Licensee to the Licensor on or before the 5<sup>th</sup> day of each month, which would cover the payment for that month or a future month, commencing 9/1/2025
- c. The Licensee will have no more than 20 participants at any given time at the training sessions on Winston Park property. The Licensee will provide a list of each sessions participants designating residents to the clubhouse office.

- d. At least 75% of the participants at any given training session must be Winston Park residents
- e. If the <u>Winston Park HOA</u> is having any events that interfere with a scheduled training session, the <u>Winston Park</u> event would have priority over the training session.
- f. The Licensee will use a portion of the blacktop area and will designate that area with cones. There needs to be ample space available for the Winston Park residents to be able to use the remaining blacktop area.
- g. No other vehicles shall be parked within the park area except the <u>Level Up</u> <u>Mobile gym</u> truck and trailer. The participants vehicles need to parked on the perimeter of the park property.
- h. Entry and exit gate at the park area will remain locked. The gate will be opened prior to the Licensees arrival and locked after Licensee exits park.
- PERMITTED USE OF THE PROPERTY. Daniel Prol will be the trainer present for all sessions on Winston Park property / blacktop area. Licensee agrees to use a Portion of the BLACKTOP Property in the Park area, on Tuesdays and Thursdays only between the hours of 5:30 PM - 6:30 PM and Saturday only between the hours of 8 AM - 9 , for Level Up Mobile Gym classes and no other purposes, and no other days or times. Level Up Mobile Gym will have 15 minutes before each class to set up and 15 minutes after each class to clean up. Any modifications to the days of use of this Property or its hours of operation by Licensees will require written approval in advance by the Licensor, which will be evidenced as a written addendum to this License Agreement upon such approval signed by both parties. Licensee covenants to comply with all applicable zoning and other governmental regulations. Licensee, at its own expense, shall comply with and promptly carry out all orders, requirements or conditions imposed by the ordinances, laws and regulation of all of the governmental authorities having jurisdiction over the Property, which are occasioned by or required in the conduct of Licensee's business within the Property and to obtain all licenses, permits and the like required to permit Licensee to lawfully occupy the Property. Licensee represents at the time of execution of this agreement that it possess all necessary licenses and approvals from the State of Florida and Miami Dade County to legally operate Licensee's business. Storage of Licensee's personal property shall not be permitted on the Property.
  - (a) Licensee or any of Licensee's assistants, instructors or employees must as a material condition of this License have successfully passed a background check per Florida Dept. of Children and Families, or an equivalent background check (and provide written proof of the same to the Association prior to usage).
  - (b) Winston Park Clubhouse Facilities. The Licensee shall be responsible for the advising of and adherence by participants, attendees and any other persons

associated with any Licensee lessons, activities or other events, that they are to leave the Property when the lesson or activity ends. All other Association facilities including but not limited to swimming pools, playground, basketball court, volleyball court, adult and teen lounges, gymnasium, lake area and picnic areas are off limits and not to be entered into or used except by Winston Park residents and their accompanied guests.

- 5. <u>CARE OF THE PROPERTY</u>. Licensee will use and occupy said Property and appurtenances in a careful, safe, and proper manner; and shall keep the Property and appurtenances thereof in a clean, **sanitary**, sightly, and healthy condition, in accordance with the highest standards of the neighborhood. Upon termination of this Agreement, the Licensee shall return the Property in the same condition of cleanliness, repair, and sightliness as at the date of the execution hereof; reasonable wear and tear excepted.
- 6. <u>LICENSOR'S RIGHT TO ENTER</u>. Licensee hereby permits Licensor, his agents, or employees to have access to and enter said Property at all reasonable and necessary times after notice during the days and hours Licensee is to occupy the Property, to inspect the Property, or for any purposes connected with the repair, improvement, care and management of the Property and the building in which the same are situated. Licensee acknowledges and agrees that Licensor may have access to and enter the Property at all other times not reserved for Licensee's occupancy, without notice or permission of the Licensee.
- 7. <u>ASSIGNMENT</u>. Licensee further agrees not to assign or transfer this License or any use interest therein or sublet the Property or any part thereof and any such attempted assignment or subletting shall be invalid and of no force or effect unless approved by Licensor, in writing.
- 8. <u>"AS-IS" ACCEPTANCE OF PROPERTY</u>. Licensee accepts the Property from Licensor in "As-Is" condition, except to the extent specifically provided elsewhere in this Agreement.
- 9. <u>ALTERATIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS</u>. Licensee shall not make any alterations or improvements to the Property without the advance express written permission of the Licensor, including any alterations or improvements that may be required as a result of their use of the Property. Any alterations or improvements or fixtures shall be paid by the Licensee, shall become property of the Licensor, and shall remain with the Property upon termination of this License Agreement. Licensee shall not cause any construction or any other lien to be recorded against the Property, and if such a lien is recorded the Licensee shall immediately payoff said lien or bond the same and shall to the fullest extent of the law indemnify hold the Licensor harmless and pay to the Licensor as Additional remuneration under this License any attorney fees (whether suit be brought or not) or costs incurred by the Licensor as a result of, or arising out of such a Lien. This paragraph shall survive the termination of this Agreement.

INDEMNIFICATION OF LICENSOR. In exchange for separate consideration 10. paid by the Association to the Licensee, the sufficiency of which is acknowledged (\$10.00), the parties agree that notwithstanding the insurance requirements of the Licensee required herein, that the Licensee at all times, shall indemnify and hold harmless Licensor from and against all claims and any type of damages arising out of, relating to or by reason of this License or Licensee's use of the Property, or any activity, work or things done, permitted or suffered by Licensee in or about the Property or elsewhere and shall further indemnify and hold harmless Licensor from and against any and all claims arising out of, relating to or by reason of from any breach under the terms of this License arising out of, relating to or by reason of any negligence or intentional acts of the Licensee, or any of Licensee's agents, servants or employees and from and against all costs, attorneys fees, expenses and liabilities incurred in the defense of any such claim (whether suit be brought or not), and Licensee upon notice from Licensor shall defend the same at Licensee's expense by legal counsel satisfactory to Licensor. Licensee, as a material part of the consideration to Licensor, hereby assumes all risk of damage to property or injury to persons, in, upon or about the Property arising from any cause and Licensee hereby waives all claims in respect thereof against Licensor.

All of the foregoing rights, remedies, powers and elections of Licensor reserved herein are cumulative, and pursuit of any of the foregoing remedies shall not preclude other remedies provided by law, nor shall pursuit of any remedy herein provided constitute a forfeiture or waiver of any remuneration due to Licensor hereunder or of any damages occurring to Licensor by reason of the violation of any of the terms, provisions and covenants herein contained. No waiver by Licensor or any violation or breach of any of the terms, provisions and covenants herein contained shall be deemed or construed to constitute a waiver of any other violation or breach of any of the terms, provisions and covenants herein contained. Forbearance by Licensor to enforce one or more of the remedies herein provided upon an event of default shall not be deemed or construed to constitute a waiver of such default.

## This paragraph shall survive the termination of this Agreement.

- 11. <u>BROKERAGE</u>. Licensor and Licensee warrant that no real estate broker is entitled to a commission in this transaction.
- 12. <u>ATTORNEY'S FEES</u>. In the event of any default **or breach** by Licensee in any provision of this Agreement, Licensee agrees to pay all costs expended by Licensor in the enforcement of the terms hereof, including attorney's fees (which shall also include any fees on account of appellate matters), whether suit be instituted or not.
- 13. <u>GOVERNING LAW AND VENUE</u>. This License shall be construed under and in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida. Any legal proceedings arising from this License shall be brought in a **State of Florida** court of competent jurisdiction **with venue** in Miami-Dade County, Florida.

- 14. <u>ENTIRE AGREEMENT</u>. This License contains the entire agreement between the parties and no statement or representation of either party, or of their agents, shall form a part hereof or be binding upon the other party hereto. This License shall not be changed or modified except by written instrument signed by the parties hereto. The covenants, conditions, and agreement made and entered into by the parties hereto shall be binding upon their respective heirs, successors, legal representatives, and assigns. Failure to comply with any of the covenants or conditions stated herein shall be sufficient cause to terminate the Contract. Licensee agrees to abide by Licensor's Rules and Regulations and any amendments thereto.
- 15. **SEVERABILITY:** In the event any provisions of this License shall be declared invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of the License terms shall continue to be binding and enforceable upon the parties hereto.

## 16. <u>INSURANCE</u>:

- (a) Licensee shall at all times during the term hereof keep in force and at its own expense public liability insurance in companies acceptable to Licensor sufficient to cover such indemnification and naming as insured both Licensor and Licensee, with minimum limits of Two Million and No/100 Dollars (\$2,000,000.00), on account of bodily injuries to or death of more than one person as the result of any one accident or disaster, and One Hundred Thousand and No/100 (\$100,000.00) on account of damage to property, and Licensee will further deposit the policy or policies of such insurance, or certificates thereof, with Licensor. Licensor shall be reflected as an additional insured under the Licensee's insurance policies.
  - (i) The public liability insurance policy covering the Licensee and/or any of his/her/its assistants or employees must contain coverage for sexual abuse, molestation and assault and battery.
- (b) Workmen's Compensation insurance coverage in the amounts required by Florida Statutes.
- (c) Licensee will furnish Licensor, on or before Licensee takes possession, copies of policies or certificates of insurance evidencing coverage required by this Agreement. All policies required hereunder shall contain an endorsement providing that the insurer will not cancel or materially change the coverage of said policy or policies without first giving thirty (30) days prior written notice thereof to Licensor.
- (d) All Licensee insurance policies stated above shall be required to be in full force and effect during the entire term of the Agreement; failure of Licensee to provide current proofs of insurance above or upon lapse of coverage, shall allow the Association to terminate this Agreement immediately without penalty or liability for the remainder of the Agreement.

- (e) The parties agree that the Licensee insurance policies are agreed to be primary and non-contributory with no contribution or subrogation rights against the Association is named as additional insured.
- CASUALTY: In the event Property or any part thereof, becomes damaged or 17. destroyed by fire or other casualty from any cause so as to render said Property and/or other approaches unfit for use and occupancy, a just and proportionate part of the Remuneration according to the nature and extent of the damage or injury to said Property and/or approached, shall be suspended or abated until said Property and/or approaches have been put in as good condition for use and occupancy as at the time immediately prior to such damage or destruction. Licensor shall proceed, at its expense and as expeditiously as may be practicable, to repair the damage unless, because of the substantial extent of the damage or destruction, Licensor should decide not to repair or restore the Property, in which event and at Licensor's sole option Licensor may terminate this License forthwith by giving Licensee a written notice of its intention to terminate within thirty (30) days after the date of the fire or other casualty. Licensor in its sole discretion shall not be obligated to repair, restore, or replace any fixture, improvement, alteration, furniture or other property owned, installed or made by Licensee, all of which shall be repaired, restored or replaced by Licensee. Licensee shall immediately notify Licensor of any damage to the Property caused by fire or any other casualty. No damage, compensation, or claim shall be payable by Licensor for inconvenience, loss of business or annoyance arising from any repair or restoration of any portion of the Property.
- 18. EVENTS OF DEFAULT: The occurrence of any of the following shall constitute an event of default under this Agreement:
  - (a) During the term of this Agreement, the Licensee shall abandon or vacate the property (or in writing state that the Licensee has vacated the Property); or
  - (b) The Licensee shall fail to pay any part or all of the money due to Licensor under this agreement, or any money now or hereafter due to Licensor and such non-payment shall remain for a period of **three (3) calendar days**; or
  - (c) The Licensee shall fail to perform or shall breach any term, covenant or condition or provision of the is agreement and such non-performance or breach shall not be cured within ten (10) days after written notice of the default from the Licensor is delivered electronically (email) or by personal delivery to the Property or; or
  - (d) The Licensee shall permit or suffer to exist any lien, encumbrances, assessment, judgment or charge upon the Licensor's or Licensee's interest in this Licenseor the Property, and/or fixtures, improvements and furnishings located thereon; or
  - (e) The Licensee is unable to pay its debts as they become due, **be deemed insolvent or file for bankruptcy**; or
  - (f) Licensee shall violate any Municipal, County, State and Federal laws now in force or which may hereafter be in force; or

- 23. Time of the Essence. Time is of the essence under this Agreement.
- 24. Captions: Number and Gender. The paragraph headings herein contained are for purposes of identification only and shall not be considered in construing this Agreement. All terms and words used in this Agreement, regardless of the number or gender in which they are used, shall be deemed to include any other number and any other gender as the context may require.
- 25. Third Parties. None of the obligations hereunder of either party shall run to or be enforceable by any party other than the other party to this Agreement or by a party deriving rights hereunder as a result of an assignment permitted pursuant to the terms hereof.
- 26. <u>Rule of Construction</u>. The parties acknowledge that each party and its counsel have reviewed and revised this Agreement and that the normal rule of construction to the effect that any ambiguities are to be resolved against the drafting party shall not be employed in the interpretation of this Agreement or any amendments or exhibits hereto.
- 27. <u>Participant waiver and release Agreement form requirement:</u> As a material term of this Agreement, Licensee shall have every adult and minor (under age 18) participant execute the attached Release Agreement of Liability, Hold Harmless & Indemnification Agreement and Photo Release Agreement in the favor of the Association, prior to participation in any approved activity herein, and forward copies of all such forms to the Association office for each such participant.
- 28.
